Once again we had a beautiful fall weekend for our show, which may have affected overall attendance, but we did see a busy Saturday, though Sunday was somewhat slower.

The tables were filled with a large variety of items brought out by Lee David, Michael Evans, Robert Gall, Bruce Goff, Curfew James, Leith James, Ed Kereluk, Murray Kish (SMAS), Colin Kunkel, Al Magnus, Gordon McDonald, Brian Miller, Dave Porter, Len Schmidt, Joey Stebanuk (SMAS), Eugene Stacyszyn and Frank Turgeon. According to Len, items on display included 43 armour, 187 aircraft (including helicopters), 85 automobiles (including motorcycles), seven figures, 26 dioramas, two miscellaneous items (engines, etc.), 4 ships/submarines, and eleven space/sci-fi.
